### **SHIP CLEANLINESS DIRECTIVE**

Pursuant to license requirements imposed on the Esperance Port by the Department of Environment and Conservation, and further to the requirements of international and statutory Maritime legislation, this instruction directs Masters of all vessels to ensure that cargo residues do not enter Esperance Port waters from their vessel by any means.

Under no circumstances should cargo residues be allowed to enter port waters, including during periods of heavy rain, high winds or de-ballasting of ballast cargo holds.

Non Compliance with this directive may result in prosecution of the ships Master under Australian Marine Orders and Environmental Legislation.
